

This book is like a travelogue of where these elongated skulls are found and a rundown of the local history for many locales and through a long timespan. This is a factual rather than purely speculative account of the elongated skulls. In particular, the locating of the skulls along the ancient route inherited by the lncans from a prior civilization was hugely interesting. The discussion of the

sutures in some skulls made me think of the sutureless skulls of Malta, which surely resemble those of South America.
