

The best simply. I learned to play bridge years ago using Shirley's 4 book series, of which this is one of the books. I went on to play duplicate and even won a few Master's Points in tournaments. I loaned the books to someone who never returned them, so when I decided to start playing again I bought Shirley's updated series to refresh my skills. These books are short, simple, clear, and to the point. They explain the logic of the various bidding, play, and conventions so that it is easy to understand how and why you use them - which makes it easy to remember and implement each lesson.

This is a great series for a beginner or someone coming back to bridge after many years or anyone who wants to be a better player. Do all the exercises and you will learn a lot. Go through all 4 of them in order.

This "pamphlet" contain little to no discussion of the play of the hand, just a few cursory words. Example hands contain questions but the correct answers were inconveniently printed upside down necessitating rotating the pamphlet. I'm not sure what level player this pamphlet was supposed to help but it surely wasn't the audience described. The only redeeming feature of the document was it was to cheap to go to the effort of returning.

This was an easy to read book filled with great strategies for actually playing a hand. A must read for those learning or re-learning to play bridge.
